On April 20, 2016, the Kapi`olani Community College Faculty Senate, representing 16 departments and units campus wide, voted 13 to 3 (81%) in support of a vote of no confidence against Chancellor Leon Richards' leadership and management of the College.

The Faculty Senate passed the following resolution.

Resolution:

"The Senate moves that the results of the April 20, 2016 Kapi`olani Community College Faculty Senate vote of no confidence against Chancellor Leon Richards be sent to John Morton, Vice President for Community Colleges; David Lassner, President for the University of Hawaii; and Randolph Moore, Chair for the University of Hawaii Board of Regents.

Be it further moved that John Morton, Vice President for Community Colleges, remove the Chancellor from all decision making authority, ask the Chancellor to resign, and remove the Chancellor from the campus immediately. A copy of the Faculty Senate Executive Committee's letter to the faculty dated April 7, 2016 be transmitted with the results of the vote of no confidence." (Please see attached.)
