Introduction

This report is a continuation of salary studies prepared for the University of Hawai'i Professional Assembly (UHPA) by Coffey Consulting, LLC (formerly JBL Associates, Inc.) starting in 2000, with the most recent review conducted in 2012. The current analysis draws on 2014-15 salary data reported to the Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System (IPEDS). Unlike past analyses, the individual University of Hawai'i (UH) institutions are compared with an updated peer group and the UH community college campuses are reported separately instead of as a single unit.

The report begins with an overview of the data sources, the faculty population, and the peer group selection criteria. The findings, including a historical trend analysis to measure progress in faculty salary levels relative to the peer group over time, is then presented. The report concludes with recommendations on UH's pay schedules, and estimates of the aggregate cost of these adjustments. Peer group institutions and detailed tables are provided in the appendix.

Methods

Sources of Data

Our primary data source was the faculty salary data collected by the U.S. Department of Education's Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System (IPEDS). IPEDS collects faculty salary data annually. These data are the most complete and reliable source of faculty salaries available. All the faculty salary tables in this report use 2014-15 data (salaries as of November 1, 2014). The analysis does not include lecturers or no rank faculty because UH does not use these academic faculty rank categories.

UHPA also provided Coffey with their in-house faculty salary data from June 8, 2016, which we used as a comparison of IPEDS reported salaries for UH institutions. Data was suppressed for any ranks where less than 3 faculty were reported in the individual ranking, but are included in the total averages. The results are reported in the appendix.

Cost of living difference was included as an additional analysis. Bureau of Labors Consumer price index (CPI) (<u>http://www.bls.gov/cpi/cpid1604.pdf</u> (table 24)) for all urban consumers in Honolulu, HI were compared to the national United States average. The CPI for Honolulu in 2015 was 260.165 and the US was 237.017.

Population

The UH faculty salaries used in our analysis are those reported on the federal IPEDS form. Only full-time faculty members that teach on a 9/10-month contract are reported. Faculty members include only full-time employees who teach at least half time. For example, if someone gets released time for administrative responsibilities, but continues to teach at least half time they would be included, but an administrator who taught a class would not. Individuals who may be included on the faculty salary schedule, but do not teach, are not included.

The data do not include salaries of part-time faculty or faculty members on sabbatical leave who are not currently on the payroll; if they are on the payroll their regular salary or the salary of the person replacing them is reported even though the staff may be receiving a reduced annuity while on leave. Faculty members on an 11/12-month contract are included in the appendix, but not as part of the analysis. In most cases, faculty members on an 11/12-month contract have responsibilities beyond teaching. Often, salaries of this group represent those faculty members with research projects or quasi-administrative duties.

The reported salaries do not represent any extra compensation or overload teaching responsibilities for which the individual may receive extra pay from the institution. Faculty members who volunteer or are paid by other organizations (for example, the U.S. Department of Defense may pay an ROTC instructor) are not included. The data also do not include clinical staff in the medical school, as universities cannot always differentiate clinical practice income from salaries paid for teaching.

When making comparisons of average salaries over time, it is important to remember that some faculty members may leave and others may be hired, so the comparisons over time will represent a different mix of faculty members. This fact is less important in larger institutions, but could have a noticeable effect in the case of smaller institutions.

Public higher education institutions have continued to face funding challenges as states have struggled with budget deficits. In some cases, faculty members at public institutions may have been forced to take unpaid furlough days. The salaries reported here do not include any reduction taken in salaries due to these staffing changes or leave taken.

Peer Group Selection Criteria

The peer groups are compared individually with the 10 UH institutions:

- 1. University of Hawai'i at Hilo (UHH)
- 2. University of Hawai'i at West Oahu (UHWO)
- 3. University of Hawai'i at Manoa (UHM)
- 4. University of Hawai'i Maui College (MAU)
- 5. Hawai'i Community College (HAW)
- 6. Honolulu Community College (HON)
- 7. Kapi'olani Community College (KAP)
- 8. Kaua'i Community College (KAU)
- 9. Leeward Community College (LEE)
- 10. Windward Community College (WIN)

Each of the 10 UH institutions are compared with two to four peer groups, depending on the size of the peer group, from the following selection methods:

• Comparable institutions selected nationally based on a formula that includes type and control, enrollment and expenditure per student

- Limited to a group of Western region institutions selected using the same formula as used in the national selection
- Institutions selected by the UH administration or selected by the UHPA

The redundancy of peers selected by different methods provides more confidence in the results. For example, because UHWO is such a small campus, it has fewer peers than the other, larger UH campuses.

We selected the <u>first set</u> of peers using a peer computer program. It selects peers based on Carnegie Classification category (institutional type and control), enrollment and educational expenditures per student. The <u>second set</u> of peers was selected using the same rules, but the search was limited to the Western region states. California dominates this peer group, but it represents the closest employment area to Hawai'i. The university administration selected the <u>third set</u> of peers and for UHM the administration selected a <u>fourth set</u> of peers based on benchmarks from past analysis. These institutions represent those peers that the University identified as being most similar to the 10 UH institutions. A list of all the peer institutions is provided in the appendix.

A total peer group is included in the analysis; this larger merged peer group comprised of the three (four for UHM) sets of peers was used to identify the average salaries and the 80th percentile salary for each UH institution and for faculty by academic rank in each institution. This Total Peer group is used in all of the comparisons with details for each separate peer group when appropriate.

The calculation for the average peer group salary uses weighted data. Multiplying the average salary by the number of faculty members in the institution provides the weight for each institution that is used to calculate the average for the peer group. Colleges or universities in the peer group with a large number of faculty members count more in the average than do smaller institutions.

The second measure used in the comparisons is the percentile rank of the institutions compared with their peers. The median institution would fall at the fiftieth percentile. Half the colleges are above and half are below, regardless of the number of faculty members in the college. In this case, all the institutions count as the same, regardless of the number of faculty members in an institution.

Results

Salary History of UH Campuses

The average salaries for full-time 9/10-month contract UH faculty members have increased in the last 4 years. Salaries are corrected for inflation based on Honolulu, HI reported consumer price index (CPI) from Bureau of Labor and Statistics (BLS) in Chart 1. Salaries in current dollars, not corrected for inflation, are reported on Chart 2.





Chart 1. Average UH salaries of faculty on 9/10 month contracts by campus in constant 2015 dollars, 2011-12 through 2014-15

In current dollars there is less change visible in the salary increases within the community colleges at UH. The UH of West Oahu has seen a decrease in the most recent year on average in constant and current dollars.





The number of 9/10-month faculty members by academic rank in the UH system from 2011-12 through 2014-15 have seen a shift occurring. Associate professors have increased 20% and instructors have increased 13% during the last four years. Assistant professors have declined 7% during the same time

period. Full professors are still the largest overall group although they are reporting a 3% decline in numbers.




Chart 3. Number of 9/10-month contract faculty members teaching in UH system, 2011-12 to 2014-15

Comparison with Peers

The next series of charts shows how each UH campus average faculty salaries of 9/10-month faculty members by academic rank compare with their peers. Unlike previous studies where the community colleges were combined into one institution this report will show each institution separately.

The UH community college salaries are larger than those of their peers for most ranks, with exceptions for instructors where they lag behind their peers at most of the UH community colleges. Kauai community college (chart 7) differs as professor salaries are less than their peers and instructors are earning higher salaries than their peers.





Chart 4. Hawaii Community College average salary by academic rank compared with peer groups, 2014-15

Chart 5. Honolulu Community College average salary by academic rank compared with peer groups, 2014-15








Chart 6. Kapiolani Community College average salary by academic rank compared with peer groups, 2014-15









Chart 8. Leeward Community College average salary by academic rank compared with peer groups, 2014-15








Chart 10. Winward Community College average salary by academic rank compared with peer groups, 2014-15

UH Manoa (Chart 11) is on par with its peers except when compared to the UHPA selected peer group. UH Hilo (Chart 12) is below the national peer group for professors, associates and average salaries.




Chart 11. University of Hawai'i at Manoa average salary by academic rank compared with peer groups, 2014-15





Chart 12. University of Hawai'i at Hilo average salary by academic rank compared with peer groups, 2014-15





Historical Change in Rank of UH Institutions

The following charts change the basis of comparison from the average salaries to the percentile rank of each UH institution within the peer group. These charts rank the institutional average salaries in the distribution of the peer institutions. A 50th percentile rank means that half the peer colleges are above and half are below the UH institution. An 80th percentile rank means that 80% of the peer colleges are lower than the UH institution and 20% were higher.

In past studies UH campuses were all below the 40th percentile, except for UH West Oahu, through 2010-11. In 2014-15 only Leeward community college remains below the 40th percentile and UH West Oahu continues to be in the top grouping when compared to the total peer group.




Chart 14. Percentile rank of UH compared to the total peer group, 2014-15

The percentile rank of each UH institution is lower when compared to the national selected peer group, except for Leeward community college.




Chart 15. Percentile rank of UH compared to the national selected peer group, 2014-15

~salary outside range of peer group salaries




Chart 16. Percentile rank of UH compared to the western selected peer group, 2014-15

*no peer group




Chart 17. Percentile rank of UH compared to the UH selected peer group, 2014-15

Percentile rank for each academic category relative to the same academic category in the total peer group varies for each institution. There are instances where a 100th percentile rank is reported as the UH institutions academic rank average salary is higher than the peer group. The ranking by academic category shows variation among the campuses.




Chart 18. Percentile rank of UH compared to the total peer group by academic rank, 2014-15

Projection of UH Salaries Using Planned Increases

As of January 1, 2010, all faculty members hired on or before December 31, 2009, whose salaries are paid from appropriated funds (e.g. general, special, revolving, or appropriated federal funds) had their base salaries temporarily decreased by six and two-thirds percent (6.667%). A compensation plan was set in place to increase faculty salaries by 2014. In 2013 and 2014 the faculty received a 3 percent across-the-board salary increase. The faculty received an across-the-board salary increase of 4 percent in 2015 and will receive the same increase in 2016.

The following charts show the effect of these increases between now and 2014. The data show the increase of 4 percent for the 2015-16 year with an additional 4 percent increase in 2016-17, followed by an expected minimum of 3 percent increase in the following year. The result shows the planned increase in current dollars between 2014-15 and 2017-18. The increased salaries are compared with the projected average for the peer institutions. The increase for the peer institutions is calculated by extrapolating the average observed increase since 2011-12 through 2014-15, which ranged from -1.4 to 2.8 percent (see appendix).

The UH community colleges average salaries are above the total peer group for professors, associates and assistant professors. Honolulu, Kapiolani and Winward community college instructors remain below their peers even with the proposed salary increases.





Chart 19. Hawai'i Community College Projected Salary Using Planned Increases Compared with Peers, 2015-16 to 2017-18

Chart 20. Honolulu Community College Projected Salary Using Planned Increases Compared with Peers, 2015-16 to 2017-18









Chart 22. Kauai Community College Projected Salary Using Planned Increases Compared with Peers, 2015-16 to 2017-18









Chart 24. University of Hawai'i Maui College Projected Salary Using Planned Increases Compared with Peers, 2015-16 to 2017-18







Chart 25. Winward Community College Projected Salary Using Planned Increases Compared with Peers, 2015-16 to 2017-18

UH Manoa salaries are very close to those paid by peer institutions. Full professors' salaries fall below their peers even with the expected salary increases greater than their peers.





UH Hilo and West Oahu faculty members are paid more on average than those in the peer institutions. Following past trends, it would be reasonable to assume this will continue into the near future.





Chart 27. University of Hawai'i Hilo Projected Salary Using Planned Increases Compared with Peers, 2015-16 to 2017-18





Summary and Recommendations

Salaries for UH faculty members have been on an upward trajectory since 2002-03. After Hawai'i implemented the proposed increases in 2012, 2013 and 2014 it appears that salaries have begun to be on par with peers and even gaining in some cases. Although this still does not take into consideration the differences in cost of living. The Council for Community and Economic Research (<u>https://www.c2er.org/</u>), which is recognized by the Bureau of Labor and Statistics as the leading authority in cost of living calculations, has cited that Hawai'i had the highest cost of living for the annual 2015 reporting year. The closest region in cost of living is Washington, DC and it costs 15 percent higher to live in Hawai'i. The difference reported for California and Alaska is 26 percent. Oregon is a 30 percent difference and Washington is a 59 percent difference. Other top peer states from this report compared to Hawai'i are Texas at 82 percent, Arizona at 71 percent, Minnesota at 66, Pennsylvania at 64, and New York at 24 percent.

If a professor from California were earning an average salary of \$125,000 and was considering a move to Hawai'i to take on the same position they would need to earn an average \$157,690 salary to keep on par with their current cost of living. Although this report shows that UH appears to be out earning its peers in many instances, the cost of living shows there is still a disparity in what faculty members are earning.

Looking at the institutional percentile ranking by academic rank, it appears that UH instructors' salaries generally fall below their peers at a greater rate than do the average salaries paid to professors, associate or assistant professors.

Looking to the future, the planned increases to faculty salaries in Hawai'i will probably keep UH salaries in the same relationship with peers as shown in 2014-15. UH instructors at community colleges will continue to lag peers, while UHM will trail their peers, and faculty salaries across the board at UHH and UHWO will exceed salaries paid to faculty in the peer group.
