Lecturers and I2 faculty who are <u>not</u> receiving full grants from their home campus and who are UHPA members are eligible to apply. Lecturers who are currently teaching half-time or more (7 credits @ UHM, UHH, UHWO or 8 credits @ CCs) may apply. Fulltime and halftime I2 faculty may apply. If you are not an UHPA member, you may join now to become eligible.¹

Applicants will be notified by May 13, 2013 as to whether they have been awarded an UHPA grant or not. Upon completion of the HGT Seminar, awardees must submit a brief report to UHPA.
